3.5	Do you have written procedures for recognizing and reporting compromised seals/ containers to Customs officials or the appropriate authorities?			
3.6	Do you notify business partners (subcontractors and agents) of their obligation to carry out container inspections and/or complete checklists and keep documentation of such notification?			
3.7	Do you have a written process to ensure high security seals are affixed to all loaded containers to include evidence (certification) that seals meet or exceed the current PAS ISO 17712 standards?			
3.8	Do you have a documented process to track and monitor drivers (e.g. GPS, radios, cell phones or other 2-way communication)?			

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3.9	Do you maintain logs or other recording process to document outbound cargo while in transit to port or consolidation points?			
3.10	Do you have written policies, procedures, and checklists with instructions to drivers, transportation service providers, or consolidators regarding container tracking, check-in times, routes they are required to follow, confirmation of delivery, etc.?			
3.11	Do you have copies of contracts and/or agreements with truckers that stipulate security requirements expected to be followed?
